The Hamlin County Board of Adjustment met on March 23, 2026, at the Hamlin County 4-H Building in Hayti, SD. Board Members present were Robbie Fedt, Martin Prouty, Scott Popham, Stuart Schubloom, Alex Holzwarth. No additional nominations were made. Heuer asked for a motion to cast a unanimous ballot in favor of Fedt. Motion by Holzwarth, Second by Prouty Voice all vote. Motion CARRIED (5-0).
